

# KOURTAKI



**DESIGNATION:** A wine produced from two grape varieties of the Peloponnese, in the southern inland of Greece.

**GRAPE VARIETAL:** Moscofilero, Rhoditis

**HARVEST & WINEMAKING:** Both Moscofilero and Rhoditis varieties flourish in the vineyards at a height of around 2,000 feet, and this in combination with low summer temperatures promotes the slow ripening of the grapes which gives a finesse to the wine.

**CHARACTERISTICS:** It possesses a delicate, somewhat flowery bouquet with a refined, lively and fruity character.

**FOOD PAIRINGS:** Perfect with fish, seafood, white meats, appetizers, salads and a wide variety of dishes. Served chilled.

**UPC:** 13791-01716

**DESIGNATION:** It originates from the region of Nemea in the southern mainland of Greece the Peloponnese.

**GRAPE VARIETAL:** Nemea

**HARVEST & WINEMAKING:** High, mountainous vineyards in the Nemea region of Corinthia, in the north east of the Peloponnese (the southern mainland of Greece).

**CHARACTERISTICS:** It possesses a characteristic ruby color, rich aroma and develops a pleasant roundness and fruitiness on the palate.

**FOOD PAIRINGS:** Excellent with red meats, game and strong cheeses. Serve at room temperature.
