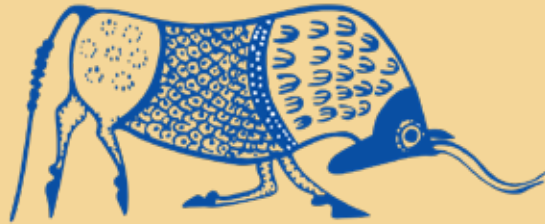

Harvest & Winemaking: Foothills of the north-facing slopes of the mountains of central Crete.

Characteristics: Cherry to garnet red color. The nose reveals a bouquet of sweet black fruit and raisins. Medium-bodied, the palate delivers a flavor of ripe berry fruit and soft tannins alongside just enough acidity to support and bolster the components of the wine. The finish is pleasing and of decent length. This is a pleasant, everyday drinking wine.

A pale, light straw color. A delightful floral bouquet is exhibited on the nose with just a touch of citrus throughout, while good acidity balances the quite delicate fruit, and the finish is long.

Pairings: A wine to accompany grilled meats and pasta with red sauce.

All light dishes, salads, fish and seafood.
